12	in connection with the Papago Indian Reservation.

14	965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (c) of Article						
15	V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the						
16	Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review						
17	by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
