

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(All Federally Funded Programs)
(to make Quarterly Reports)

RES. NO. 24-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the financial conditions of the
2 Tribe and has been advised that audits of several federally
3 funded programs operated by the Tribe indicate that the Tribe
4 may have to reimburse the Federal Government substantial sums
5 of money improperly used or accounted for by such programs; and

6 WHEREAS, the Council intends to familiarize itself more completely with
7 the Tribe's federally funded programs, and wishes to assure
8 itself that such programs are properly administered and operate
9 within their budgets.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that all federally
11 funded programs be included with the rest of the tribal programs
12 and make quarterly reports available to all Tribal Council
13 Members, starting with the next quarterly report.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
15 day of April, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 858.0 for; 107. against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to
17 the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of
18 the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the
19 Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
20 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
21 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its
22 enactment by the Papago Council and is not subject to review by the Secretary
23 of the Interior.
