RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL (Authorizing FY-80 Papago Farms) (Recontract)

RES. NO. 28-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has successfully completed the first phase of the Papago Farms Agriculture Development project, and has recontracted for 2 \$20,000 made available in FY-80 by the Bureau of Indian Affairs for 3 4 such purpose; and WHEREAS, Congress has made available to the Papago Tribe the sum of One Million Dollars for the further development of the Papago Farms Project, and 6 7 the Papago Farming Authority has approved the attached FY 1980 Budget and Budget Justification for the use of such funds; and 8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed such Budget and Budget Justification 9 and the recommendation of the Papago Farming Authority. 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve 11 12 the attached Budget and Budget Justification for the Papago Farms Project; does hereby authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs 13 to recontract for such Project accordingly; and does authorize and 14 direct the Chairman, or Vice-Chairman and the Secretary of the Papago 15 Council, and other appropriate officers of the Papago Tribe to nego-16 tiate and execute such contract, and any amendments, on behalf of the 17 Papago Tribe. 18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of April, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 664 for; 111 against; 190 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and 21 By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, 22 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
