

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Resolution No, 29-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe presently operates two education programs for
2 Indian children, ages 0 to 4 years, the Papago Early Childhood
3 Program and the Papago Head Start Program; and
4 WHEREAS, it is the long range goal of the Papago Tribe to merge these two
5 programs under one administration in order to better serve children;
6 and
7 WHEREAS, the United States Congress has appropriated \$75,800 through the
8 Bureau of Indian Affairs for the purpose of assisting the Early
9 Childhood programs on the Papago Reservation; and
10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does desire to contract for these funds which will
11 provide support for the Papago Early Childhood and Papago Head Start
12 Programs for the period of May 1, 1980 through September 30, 1980,
13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does
14 authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with
15 the Papago Tribe under P.L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for the
16 provision of early childhood education services in accordance with the
17 attached program, staffing and budget request,
18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Mr. Max H, Norris, Chairman, or in his absence, Mr.
19 Enos J, Francisco, Jr., Vice-Chairman or Ms. Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer
20 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any
21 amendments thereto for the duration of the contract,
22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
23 day of April, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
24 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority
25 vested in the Council by Section 2 (a), (d) & (f) of Article V of the
26 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat,
984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior
and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council,
