

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Preapplication for)  
( Title VI, )  
( Older American Act, Grant )

RES. NO. 30-80

1 WHEREAS, Congress has authorized direct grants to Indian Tribal organizations  
2 by Article VI of the Older Americans Act, as amended, in order to  
3 promote delivery of social services, including nutrition services, to  
4 Indians, age 60 and older; and  
5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe's Wise One's Elderly Program was organized to deliver  
6 such services to qualified residents of the Papago Reservation; and  
7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby auth-  
8 orize the Papago Tribe's Wise One's Elderly Program to prepare a Pre-  
9 application for a Title VI Grant, and does hereby authorize and direct  
10 the Chairman or Vice-Chairman, and the Secretary or other appropriate  
11 officials of the Papago Council to execute such Preapplication, or  
12 any amendments thereto, for and on behalf of the Papago Tribe of  
13 Arizona.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th day  
15 April, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965.0  
16 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested  
17 in the Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (e) of Article V of the Constitution  
18 and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on  
December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,  
1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is  
effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
