

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Amending Education Budget)

RES. NO. 34-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Department has advised the Papago Council that
2 students at the Haskell Jr. Indian College do not have funds to pay
3 for their passage home at the end of this school year; and


4 WHEREAS, it would cost approximately \$2,758.05 to charter a bus to bring the
5 27 Papago students presently at Haskell Jr. Indian College from
6 Kansas to Sells; and

7 WHEREAS, there are sufficient unused funds in the Education Committee's FY'1980
8 budget to cover the cost of such charter service.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
10 authorize and direct that the FY 1980 budget of the Papago Education
11 Committee is hereby amended to provide a travel budget of \$2,758.05
12 to pay for the cost of chartering a bus to bring the Papago students
13 attending Haskell Jr. Indian College to Sells.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
15 day of May, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 965.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to
17 the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) and Section 3 (a) and (h)
18 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,
19 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
20 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
21 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the
22 date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject
23 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


