10	does direct that this Council's regular meetings in June shall be			
11	held for four rather than the usual five days in order to bring the			
12	gift into budget.			
13	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd day of June, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of			
14	548.5 for; 171.5 against; 245 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (f) and Section 3 (h) of			
15	Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary			
16	of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the			
17	Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
