S. Department of Interior, issued, respectively 4 in Cause No. Arizona 9827 dated August 17, 1979, and in Cause No. 5 Arizona 9832 dated May 8, 1978, declared to be invalid; and 6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe, through its attorneys, gave their respective owners 7 notice to remove any personal property located on said claims by 8 9 April 1, 1980, because the Tribe intended on that date to take 10 possession of said claims and improvements located thereon; and 11 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised that said owners, or their tenants, 12 have continued to hold occupancy and possession of said claims and improvements after April 1, 1980, in violation of said notice and are 13 14 trespassers on Tribal lands; and 15 WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council has requested the Papago Tribe to acknow-16 ledge that said claims, and all improvements located thereon, are properly the property of, and are owned by the Gu Achi District, and to 17 approve an amendment of its budget to permit the expenditure of 18 19 \$1,400.00 to purchase certain removable personal property located on 20 the Crown Jewel claim from Richard Falla. 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby acknowledge that the Crown Jewel and Old Timer (Pioneer) unpatented 22 lode mining claims situated in the Gu Achi District, and all improve-23 ments located thereon, are properly the property of, and are owned by 24 the Gu Achi District, subject to the direction and control of the 25 District Council. 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council does hereby authorize the amendment of the Gu Achi District FY 1980 budget in order to permit the expenditure 28 of \$1,400.00 to purchase certain removable personal property located 29 30 on the Crown Jewel claim from Richard Falla. 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Police, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the Bureau of Land Management, the Department of Interior, and the

NO. 4/-80 (Crown Jewel and Old Timer Claims) Page Two Justice Department are hereby requested to do everything necessary to 1 obtain possession and occupancy of said unpatented mining claims for 2 and on behalf of the Papago Tribe, and to remove or cause to be 3 removed any persons residing thereon or holding or claiming possession 4 and occupancy, or rights of possession and occupancy thereto. 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, the attorneys and other appropriate 6 officers of the Papago Tribe are hereby authorized and directed to do 7 8 everything necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9 2nd _, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote day of <u>June</u> absent, 10 965.0 for; against; 0 not voting; and 0 of 0 pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a), (c), (d) and (f) and Section 3 (b), (c), (h) and (k) of Article V of the Constitution and 11 By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
