11		their salaries somewhat commensurate wit	th salaries paid by other					
12		agencies and employers, and so as to ena	able them to cope with the

14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby							
15		authorize and direct that there be ten p	percent (10%) cost of living					
16		increase to all salaries of employees of	the Papago Tribe, effective

Said Resolution is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of enactment by the Papago Council.
