

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(P.L. 93-638 Contract - Papago Farms)

RES. NO. 55-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently successfully operating the
2 Papago Farms Project under a P. L. 93-638 Contract; and

3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does desire to recontract for the further
4 development of Papago Farms in 1981 in accordance with the
5 attached budget and budget justification; and

6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR, Section 271.20 requires that all proposals to recontract
7 under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tribal Council for approval


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize
9 and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the
10 Papago Tribe under P. L. 93-638 and in accordance with attached
11 budget and budget justification

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence,
13 Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer,
14 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this contract and
15 any amendments for FY-81 for the Papago Farms Project in accordance
16 with the attached budget and budget justification


17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Management Board of the Papago Farming
18 Authority is hereby directed to meet with the Chukut Kuk District
19 Council to discuss and explain the farming and development operations
20 of the Authority and to obtain the approval from the District Council
21 of any future development plans for the Papago Farms Project.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 24th.
23 day of June, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
24 479 for; 432.5 against; 53.5 not voting; and 3 absent pursuant to
25 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article
26 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as amended,
27 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
28 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
29 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
30 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
31 enactment by the Papago Council.
