

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolution No. 56-80

1 WHEREAS, Section 104 (a) of P.L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds
2 for the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of Tribal
3 Government"; and
4 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$266,124 of FY-80 funds
5 for such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its Tribal
7 government and management.
8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the
9 Bureau of Indian Affairs to grant funds to the Papago Tribe in the
10 amount of at least \$266,124 for FY-80.
11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence,
12 Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice-Chairman, or Ms. Rosita Ruiz,
13 Treasurer are hereby authorized to negotiate and sign whatever grant
14 documents are required and, further, to negotiate and sign amendments
15 and extensions to such grant.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 24th
17 day of June, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, with a vote of
18 905 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 5 absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Council by Section II, (a) and (d) of Article V of the
20 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior
and is effective as of the date of it's enactment by the Papago Council.
