1	WHEREAS, Section 104 (a) of P.L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds
2	for the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of Tribal
3	Government"; and
4	WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$266,124 of FY-80 funds
5	for such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and
6	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its Tribal
7	government and management.
8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the
9	Bureau of Indian Affairs to grant funds to the Papago Tribe in the
10	amount of at least \$266,124 for FY-80.
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence,
12	Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice-Chairman, or Ms. Rosita Ruiz,
13	Treasurer are hereby authorized to negotiate and sign whatever grant
14	documents are required and, further, to negotiate and sign amendments
15	and extensions to such grant.
