

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolution No. 57-80

1 WHEREAS, Section 104 (a) of P.L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of funds
2 for the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of Tribal
3 Government"; and

4 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$266,124 of FY-81 funds
5 for such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its Tribal
7 government and management.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request the Bureau
9 of Indian Affairs to grant funds to the Papago Tribe in the amount
10 of at least \$266,124 for F.Y. - 81.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such funds shall be used for the development and
12 improvement of Tribal government according to the budget and work
13 program herein attached.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence,
15 Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice-Chairman, or Ms. Rosita Ruiz,
16 Treasurer are hereby authorized to negotiate and sign whatever grant
17 documents are required and, further, to negotiate and sign amendments
18 and extensions to such grant.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 24th
20 day of June, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, with a
21 vote of 905 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 5 absent, pursuant
22 to the authority vested in the Council by Section II, (a) and (d) of Article
23 V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by
24 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
25 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
26 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
27 Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
28 Council.
