

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 60-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has this day, by Resolution No. 58-80, chartered
2 the O'odham Construction and Materials Company as a tribal organiza-
3 tion wholly owned by the Papago Tribe under a Plan of Operation
4 seeking to foster the economic development of the Papago Tribe and
5 its members by engaging in the construction and materials business
6 and by providing opportunities for members of the Tribe; and
7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council wishes to foster, encourage and facilitate
8 opportunities for the O'odham Construction and Materials Company
9 to meet these purposes and objectives.
10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
11 direct that the Papago, Federal and State governments, and any of
12 their agencies, departments or subdivisions, which operate programs
13 or carry on activities within the Papago Reservation shall, to the
14 greatest extent feasible, give preference to the O'odham Construction
15 and Materials Company in the award of any contract or subcontract
16 within the scope of its Plan of Operation.
17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it (1) does hereby agree
18 to indemnify and exonerate the Aetna Casualty and Surety Company,
19 or any other surety or co-surety, from and against any and all loss
20 and expense of whatever kind, including interest, court costs and
21 counsel fees, which they may incur or sustain as a result of or in
22 connection with the furnishing of any bond(s) to the O'odham
23 Construction and Materials Company in the course of its business
24 under its Plan of Operation; (2) does hereby agree to pay all
25 premiums for each such bond(s), as they fall due; and (3) does
26 hereby authorize and direct the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary,
27 Treasurer, or other appropriate officer of the Papago Council to
28 execute on behalf of the Papago Tribe any agreement or agreements
29 of indemnity required by the Aetna Casualty and Surety Company, or
30 any other surety or co-surety, as a prerequisite to the execution
31 by them of any bond(s) or undertaking(s) for the O'odham Construc-
32 tion and Materials Company.

1 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th.
2 day of July, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
3 806 for; 159 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent pursuant to
4 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (e) and (f) and
5 Section 3 (a), (e), (g) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws
6 of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on
7 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January
8 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
9 Said Resolution is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is
10 effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
