

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
Use of Herbicides on the Papago  
Tribal Herd Range

RES. NO. 62-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe operates the Tribal Herd program as an animal  
2 husbandry and range conservation deomstration program on lands  
3 entirely within the Schuk Toak District; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution dated May 14, 1979, authorize  
5 and approve a range management plan to be administered cooperatively  
6 by the Tribal Herd Manager and the Agricultural Training Program,  
7 which management plan provided for use of herbicides to thwart the  
8 growth of mesquite on the Tribal Herd's lands; and

9 WHEREAS, residents of the Schuk Toak District and the District Council voiced a  
10 concern about the use of herbicides, especially of untested and  
11 experimental chemicals on Tribal lands; and

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council joins in this concern.


13 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby direct  
14 that the range management plan for the Tribal Herd range lands be  
15 revised in order to elimiate the use of untested chemical herbicides  
16 on the range lands of the Papago Tribal Herd.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th. day  
18 of July, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965  
19 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent pursuant to the  
20 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) (f) and (h) of Article V  
21 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as amended,  
22 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary  
23 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
24 18, 1934 (84 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
25 Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the  
26 Papago Council.


