

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 63-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Housing Authority has reported to the Papago Council about  
2 its housing program and has informed the Council of tedious and  
3 numerous acts of vandalism to new houses under construction  
4 particularly in the Sells area; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is concerned about the lawlessness which is  
6 evidenced by such vandalism and about the economic burden the  
7 vandalism imposes upon the construction contractor.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Tribal Administration  
9 work with the Papago Housing Authority, the Papago Police, the  
10 Papago Courts, the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the contractor  
11 to find means of protecting the houses under construction from  
12 further vandalism.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th  
14 day of July, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
15 965.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent pursuant to  
16 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f) and (h) of  
17 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as  
18 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
19 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
20 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
21 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
22 its enactment by the Papago Council.
