

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES.NO. 64-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has this day, by Resolution No. 63-80, directed  
2 that Tribal Administration work with the Papago Housing Authority,  
3 the Papago Police, the Papago Courts, the Bureau of Indian Affairs  
4 and the contractors of houses presently under construction for the  
5 Papago Housing Authority to find a means of protecting such houses  
6 from vandalism; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council wishes to remain informed about the problem of  
8 vandalism on the Reservation on an ongoing basis.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that there be an  
10 immediate report and regular monthly reports back to the Papago  
11 Council from Tribal Administration concerning its efforts to work  
12 out a means of protecting the houses under construction for the  
13 Papago Housing Authority from further vandalism.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th  
15 day of July, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
16 845.5 for; 0 against; 119.5 not voting; and 0 absent pursuant to  
17 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f) and (h) of  
18 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as  
19 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
its enactment by the Papago Council.
