

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

(Authorizing Grant Applications under)
(Title III and VI of the Older American Act)

RES. NO. 65-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe's "Wise Ones" Elderly Program is presently providing
2 social and nutritional services to Indians within the Papago Reserva-
3 tion, age 60 years and older, through the State of Arizona under
4 Title III of the Older American Act, as amended; and

5 WHEREAS, Congress has authorized direct grants to Indian Tribal Organizations
6 under Title VI of the Older American Act, as amended, to provide
7 social and nutritional services to persons and areas not served under
8 Title III of the Act.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
10 authorize and direct the Papago Tribe's "Wise Ones" Elderly Program
11 to apply for funding to provide nutrition and social services on the
12 Papago Reservation available under both Title III and Title VI of the
13 Older American Act, as amended.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer
15 or other appropriate officers of the Papago Council are authorized
16 to execute any grant application or contract, or amendments thereto,
17 on behalf of the Papago Tribe, necessary or incidental to the purpose
18 of this Resolution.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
20 day of July, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 885.5 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent pursuant to
22 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article
23 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
25 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
26 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
27 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
28 its enactment by the Papago Council.
