7	him for appointment to the position of Area Director.
8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
9	recommend to the Secretary of the Interior that RICHARD
10	WILSON be appointed to the position of Director of
11	the Phoenix Area of the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
12	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 30th
13	day of July, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 292. for, 250 against, 423 not voting and 2 absent, pursuant to
14	the authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the
15	Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). This Resolution is effective
16	as of this date and does not require the approval of the Superintendent of the Papago Reservation.
