

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Appointing Official Representative of)
(the Papago Tribe to the N.C.A.I.)

RES. NO. 69-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has determined that it is important that the
2 Papago Tribe be represented at meetings of the National Congress
3 of American Indians on a regular basis by a member of the Council,
4 other than its Chairman whose duties often require him to attend
5 to other matters.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that ANDREW PATRICIO
7 is hereby designated as the official representative of the Papago
8 Tribe to the National Congress of American Indians ('NCAI') for
9 the remainder of his term as representative on the Papago Council,
10 and is hereby authorized to attend meetings of the NCAI and make
11 regular reports of its activities to the Council.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the official representative of the Papago Tribe
13 to the NCAI shall, upon presentation of proper vouchers, receive
14 standard per diem Council pay, plus standard mileage or travel
15 expenses, for attending meetings of the NCAI.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 30th
17 day of July, 1980, at which a quorum was present with a vote of 762.5 For;
18 0 against; 202.5 not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the
19 authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of the
20 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the
21 Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
22 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
23 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its
24 enactment by the Papago Council and is not subject to review by the Secretary
25 of the Interior.
