

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolution No. 72-80

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Land Operations, has \$50,000.
2 of uncommitted funds available in its 1980 budget for livestock and
3 other agricultural programs on the Papago Reservation; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed various proposals for the use of such
5 funds, including a proposal of the Wind Baron Corporation, and has
6 concluded that the best use for such funds is for the maintenance,
7 rehabilitation and replacement of existing wells, and the acquisition
8 of new wells (including the type of wells meeting the criteria of the
9 Wind Baron Machine Systems) used or to be used for livestock and the
10 agricultural programs and installed, operated or maintained by the
11 Papago Well Maintenance Department.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby request
13 the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Land Operations Branch, to fund the
14 Papago Well Maintenance Department with an additional \$50,000.00 out
15 of the fiscal 1980 funds to be used for the maintenance, rehabili-
16 tation and replacement of existing wells, and the acquisition of
17 new wells used or to be used for livestock or other agricultural
18 programs on the Papago Reservation.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary or other
20 appropriate officers of the Papago Council are hereby authorized
21 and directed to negotiate, sign and amend any contract or instrument
22 on behalf of the Papago Tribe necessary to implement the purpose
23 of this Resolution.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7
25 day of August, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
26 776. for; 111 against; 0 not voting; and 5 absent; pursuant
27 to the authority vested in the Papago Council, Section 2 (a), (d), (e), (f)
28 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
29 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
30 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
31 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
32 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
