

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Energy Crisis Assistance Program)

RES. NO. 78-80

1 WHEREAS, grants are made available from the Health and Human Services
2 Agency, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, for Low
3 Income Energy Assistance Programs; and

4 WHEREAS, the FY-81 allocation for the Papago Tribe for Low Income
5 Energy Assistance Program is \$75,296.00; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago people will be better served by a direct grant from
7 the above agency, rather than through a grant from the State
8 of Arizona.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe hereby requests
10 that funds for the Low Income Energy Assistance Program be
11 made available through a direct grant.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State of Arizona be notified of this
13 request.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his
15 absence Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman, or Ms.
16 Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, is hereby authorized to execute
17 documents required for this request.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
19 day of August, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
20 of 876.5 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 88.5 absent
21 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d),
22 (e), (f) and (h) and Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and
23 By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as amended, ratified by the Papago
Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is subject to review by the Secretary of
the Interior and is effective as of the date of enactment by the Papago
Council.
