- 2. That the application of the Local Authority to the Government for a preliminary loan in an amount not to exceed 3% of the Total Development Cost which can be supported by the amount of the ACC for surveys and planning in connection with low-income housing projects of not to exceed approximately 150 dwelling units is hereby approved.
- 3. That there is no objection to the Local Authority's application to HUD for additional housing (a) due to any inconsistency localities under consideration; or (b) since a definite need for the housing exists even though a Housing Assistance Plan may not be in effect; and (c) since public facilities and services are or will be available and adequate to serve the proposed housing the areas mentioned.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 25th day of August, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
