

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Approving Application for Preliminary)
(Loan for Low Income Public Housing)

RES. NO. 81-80

1 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this locality to eliminate substandard and
2 other inadequate housing, to prevent the spread of slums and
3 blight, and to realize as soon as feasible the goal of a decent
4 home in a suitable living environment for all of its citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as
6 amended, the United States of America, acting through the Secretary
7 of Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"),
8 is authorized for undertaking and carrying out preliminary planning
9 of low income housing projects that will assist in meeting this
10 goal; and

11 WHEREAS, The Act provides that there shall be local determination of need
12 for low income housing to meet needs not being adequately met by
13 private enterprise and that the Government shall not make any
14 contract with a public housing agency for preliminary loans for
15 surveys and planning in respect to any low-income housing projects
16 unless the governing body of the locality involved has by resolution
17 approved the application of the public housing agency for such
18 preliminary loan; and

19 WHEREAS, Section 213 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974
20 provides that the local unit of government be given the opportunity
21 to comment on and/or object to the approval of an application on
22 grounds of inconsistency with local housing assistance planning;
23 and

24 WHEREAS, the Papago Indian Housing Authority (herein called "Local Authority")
25 is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a
26 preliminary loan to cover the costs of surveys and planning in
27 connection with the development of low-income housing;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT resolved by the Governing Council of the Papago Tribe
29 as follows;

- 30 1. That there exists within the jurisdiction of this Governing
31 Council a need for such low-income housing which is not
32 being met by private enterprise;

1st. Move - Henry Ramon

2nd. Move - Alex Juan
