## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Appointment of Rodeo Committee)

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has failed to appoint a Board of Directors of 1 the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association in time to organize and 2 manage the 1980 Papago Fair, Livestock Show and Rodeo; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has recommended that a temporary five member Rodeo Committee, consisting of; 5 1. Silas Hendricks 6 2. Wesley Jose 7 3. Nathan Pablo 4. Allen Throssell 8 Mark Lopez 9 be appointed to organize and manage the 1980 Annual Papago Fair, 10 Livestock Show and Rodeo with a budget of \$18,217.00, and that 11 the Committee have the part time services of a secretary to be 12 assigned to it by Tribal Administration; and 13 WHEREAS, the Papago Council concurs in the recommendation of the Budget 14 and Finance Committee. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby 15 appoint a Rodeo Committee, consisting of the following five 16 17 members of the Papago Tribe, to wit: 18 Silas Hendricks 1. Wesley Jose 2. Nathan Pablo 19 3. 4. Allen Throssell 20 Mark Lopez 21 to organize, manage and operate the 1980 Annual Papago Fair, 22 Livestock Show and Rodeo with a budget of \$18,217.00. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Rodeo Committee shall receive the part 23 24 time services of a Secretary to be assigned to it by Tribal 25 Administration, and that the Committee account to the Treasurer 26 of the Papago Council for its receipts and disbursements in 27 accordance with procedures to be established by the Treasurer. 28 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of September, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a 29 vote of <u>869.0</u> for; against; 0 0 \_ not voting; and 30

pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of enactment by the Papago Council.
