

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Application for Preliminary Loan for Low Income
Public Housing

RES. NO. 90-80

1 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this locality to eliminate substandard and other
2 inadequate housing, to prevent the spread of slums and blight, and
3 to realize as soon as feasible the goal of a decent home in a suitable
4 living environment for all of its citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as
6 amended, the United States of America, acting through the Secretary of
7 Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"), is
8 authorized to provide financial assistance to local public housing
9 agencies for undertaking and carrying out preliminary planning of low
10 income housing projects that will assist in meeting this goal; and

11 WHEREAS, the Act provides that there shall be local determination of need for
12 low income housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private
13 enterprise and that the Government shall not make any contract with a
14 public housing agency for preliminary loans for surveys and planning
15 in respect to any low-income housing projects unless the governing
16 body of the locality involved has by resolution approved the applica-
17 tion of the public housing agency for such preliminary loan; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 213 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974
19 provides that the local unit of government be given the opportunity to
20 comment on and/or object to the approval of an application on grounds
21 of inconsistency with local housing assistance planning; and

22 WHEREAS, the Papago Indian Housing Authority (herein called "Local Authority")
23 is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a
24 preliminary loan to cover the costs of surveys and planning in connection
25 with the development of low-income housing.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Council of the Papago Tribe as
27 follows:

- 28 1. That there exists within the jurisdiction of this Governing Council
29 a need for such low-income housing which is not being met by private
30 enterprise;
- 31 2. That the application of the Local Authority to the Government for
32 a preliminary loan in an amount not to exceed 3% of the total

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development cost which can be supported by the amount of the ACC surveys and planning in connection with low-income housing projects of not to exceed approximately 70 dwelling units is hereby approved.

- 3. That there is no objection to the Local Authority's application to HUD for additional housing (a) due to any inconsistency localities under consideration; or (b) since a definite need for the housing exists even through a Housing Assistance Plan may not be in effect; and (c) since public facilities and services are or will be available and adequate to serve the proposed housing and areas mentioned.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th day of September, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 894 for 0 against, 71 not voting; 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 13, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
