

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Low-Income Energy Assistance Program

RES. NO. 91-80

1 WHEREAS, grants are made available from the Department of Health and Human
2 Services for Low-Income Energy Assistance Programs; and
3 WHEREAS, the FY-81 allocation for the Papago Tribe for Low-Income Energy Assist-
4 ance program is \$75,296.00; and
5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has opted to go with a direct grant from DHHS to
6 administer the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program through the Com-
7 munity Development Program; and
8 WHEREAS, the Community Development Program has come up with a proposed plan to
9 administer this program; and
10 WHEREAS, the proposed plan must be submitted to the Department of Health and
11 Human Services for approval by October 1, 1980.
12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe hereby requests that this
13 plan be submitted to DHHS for approval.
14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the approval of this plan by DHHS that the
15 Community Development Program will administer this program in a business
16 like manner for the term of the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program
17 grant.
18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence,
19 Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice-Chairman, or in his absence, Ms.
20 Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, is hereby authorized to execute documents
21 required for this request.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th. day
23 of September, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
24 927.0 for; 0 against; 38 not voting; 0 absent, pursuant to
25 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article
26 V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by
the Papago Tribe on December 13, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Sec-
retary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of it's enactment by the
Papago Council.

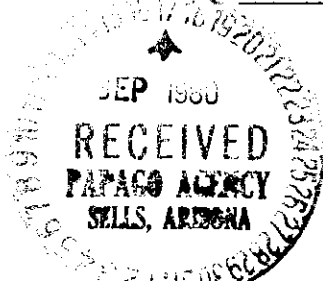
