BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the approval of this plan by DHHS that the 14 15 Community Development Program will administer this program in a business like manner for the term of the Low-Income Energy Assistance Program 16 17 grant. 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence, 19 Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice-Chairman, or in his absence, Ms. 20 Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, is hereby authorized to execute documents 21 required for this request. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th. day 22 of September, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of absent, pursuant to 23 not voting; against; 38 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by 24 the Papago Tribe on December 13, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 25 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
