

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement
Head Start Program

RES. NO. 94-80

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Project Head Start/Home Start needs to review their
2 application for the Child Food Program through the State of Arizona;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, it is mandatory that an Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement be
5 signed by the Papago Tribe as general sponsor for the Head Start
6 Program to serve breakfast, lunches and snacks to children; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council have reviewed request and feel that Head Start
8 should continue feeding the children.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve
10 the renewal of the application implementing the Child Care Food Program
11 from October 1, 1980 to September 30, 1981.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Papago Tribe is hereby authorized
13 to execute the Intergovernmental Food Service Agreement.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th.
15 day of September, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 927 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant
17 to the authority vested in the Papago Council, by Section 2 (a) and (h) of
18 Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified
by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
on January 6, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date
of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject
to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
