9		Subpart K PreKindergarten Programs, and, Subpart L Contract School
10	 	Operation and Maintenance Funds, provide for full funding for Early
11		Childhood Programs and for future Tribal Contract Schools; and
12	WHEREAS,	as stated in 25 CFR 31H (P.L. 95-561), Subpart K 31H.131 "prekinder-
13		garten programs shall be included in the Bureau's education request
14		for fiscal year 1982," and, as stated in Subpart L 31h.143, "The
15		Assistant Secretary shall arrange for full funding for operation and
16		maintenance of contract schools for fiscal year 1980;" and
17	WHEREAS,	P.L. 93-638, Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act,
18		Part 271 Contracts, Subpart B 271.12 (c) (d), gives Tribes the
19		authority to contract for "Programs or parts of programs or services
20		that are authorized but not currently operated or provided by the
21		Bureau," and for the "Operation of, or services provided by, previousl
22		private schools;" and
23	WHEREAS,	the Papago Tribe is currently operating Early Childhood Programs and
24		the Pisinemo Junior High, a previously private school, and
25	WHEREAS,	the Papago Tribe has submitted the student counts for both the Papago
26		Early Childhood Programs and the Pisinemo Junior High School as
27		required by the Indian School Equalization Program for full funding
28		beginning fiscal year 1982, and
29	WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Office of Indian Education Programs, is
30		mandated in P.L. 93-638 and P.L. 95-561, to provide quality education
31		opportunities to all Indian people.

(Indian School Equalization Program) Page Two 1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby 2 direct the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Office of Indian Education 3 Programs, to insure that it meets the legislative mandates to provide full funding for the Papago Tribe's Early Childhood Programs and for Pisinemo Junior High School at the start of fiscal year 1982. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6 day of October, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (e) of Article 7 8 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary 9 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the 10 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
