

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Vocational Rehabilitation Act Funding)

RES. NO. 99-80

1 WHEREAS, the Vocational Rehabilitation Act of 1973 was amended by P. L.
2 95-602 and Section 101 (b) (3) of the Act provides as follows:
3 For the purpose of making grants to Indian Tribes under Part D
4 of this Title, there are authorized to be appropriated for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 1979, and for each of the three
6 fiscal years thereafter, in addition to any amounts authorized
7 to be appropriated under this section, such sums as may be
8 necessary for such fiscal years, but not more than an amount
9 equal to 1 percent of the amount appropriated for that fiscal
10 year under paragraph (1) of this subsection; and

11 WHEREAS, Indian Tribes have not been made aware of this source of extra
12 funding.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Department of
14 Education be required to fully fund the 1 percent set-aside for
15 Indian Tribes mandated by Vocational Rehabilitation Act for FY 81,
16 and provide the Papago Tribe with the necessary funds for Vocational
17 Rehabilitation programs on the Papago Reservation during FY 81 and
18 subsequent fiscal years.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
20 day of October, 1980, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
21 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to
22 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (e) of Article
23 V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
25 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
26 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
27 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
28 enactment by the Papago Council.
