

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Request for Carry Over Funds)

RES. NO. 05-82

1 WHEREAS, the Treasurer of the Papago Tribe presented to the Council the  
2 Budget Review and Analysis for the fourth quarter of FY 1980-81  
3 which revealed that there was an excess of revenue over actual  
4 expenditures for FY 1980-81; and

5 WHEREAS, due to cutbacks and elimination of Federal Appropriations, a  
6 shortage of Tribal funds projected for the FY 1981-82 budget  
7 could occur; and

8 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe that any excess  
9 funds be carried over to the FY 1981-82 budget to cover any  
10 deficiencies that might occur.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that all excess  
12 revenue over actual expenditures for FY 1980-81 be carried over  
13 and included in the FY 1981-82 budget and used to cover any  
14 deficiencies that might occur as a result of any short comings  
15 in income projected in the Tribe's FY 1981-82 budget.

16 The foregoing Resolutio was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th  
17 day of January, 1982 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
18 of 1060.5 for; 0 against; 87.5 not voting; and 2 absent,  
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and  
20 (f) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of  
21 the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on  
December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January  
6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).  
Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superinten-  
dent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the  
Interior.
