

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Recommending Appointment of Superintendent)

RES NO. 06-82

1 WHEREAS, the Area Director has submitted for review by the Papago Council
2 Certificates of Best Qualified Candidates for the position of
3 Superintendent of the Papago Indian Agency, together with a summary
4 of each candidate's qualifications; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the summaries and qualifications
6 of each candidate and has found that CURTIS C. NORDWALL appears
7 best qualified to meet the needs and requirements of the
8 Papago Tribe.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
10 recommend to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Interior -
11 Indian Affairs that CURTIS C. NORDWALL be appointed to the position
12 of Superintendent of the Papago Indian Agency and that action upon
13 this recommendation be taken immediately since the Papago Tribe
14 has been without a permanent Superintendent for a period in excess
15 of two years.


16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th
17 day of January, 1982 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
18 a vote of 983 for; 41.5 against; 123.5 not voting; and 1 absent,
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (f) of
20 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
21 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 134 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is
subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


