WHEREAS, the Area Director has submitted for review by the Papago Council 1 Certificates of Best Qualified Candidates for the position of 2 Superintendent of the Papago Indian Agency, together with a summary 3 of each candidate's qualifications; and 4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the summaries and qualifications 5 of each candidate and has found that CURTIS C. NORDWALL appears 6 7 best qualified to meet the needs and requirements of the 8 Papago Tribe. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby 9 recommend to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of the Interior -10 Indian Affairs that CURTIS C. NORDWALL be appointed to the position 11 of Superintendent of the Papago Indian Agency and that action upon 12 this recommendation be taken immediately since the Papago Tribe 13 has been without a permanent Superintendent for a period in excess 14 15 of two years.
