

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Approving ANA Grant Application)

RES. NO. 07-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has by memorandum dated November 23, 1981, been  
2 advised by the Office of Administration for Native Americans of  
3 the availability on a competitive basis of financial assistance  
4 under Program Announcement No. 13512-822 for Native Americans  
5 Social and Economic Development Strategies; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council finds that the vocational training and economic  
7 upgrading program proposed in the attached grant application is  
8 a critical component of the Papago Tribe's economic development  
9 plan.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
11 approve the attached grant application prepared by the Papago  
12 Education Skill Center and O'odham Construction on behalf of  
13 the Papago Tribe, and does hereby authorize and direct the Chairman  
14 or Vice-Chairman and other appropriate officers and agents of the  
15 Papago Tribe to execute such application and any amendments or  
16 instruments incidental thereto on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th  
18 day of January, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
19 vote of 849.5 for; 184. against; 114.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pur-  
20 suant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d)  
21 and 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of  
22 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
23 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
24 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
25 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of  
26 the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
