5		of which are separate, Gila Bend - 10,400 acres; San Xavier -				
6		71,095 acres; Florence - 20 acres; Sells (main reservation) -				
7		2,744,894 acres; and				
8	WHEREAS,	the Papago CHR's have been and are a vital part of the health				
9		delivery system on the Papago Reservations serving a population				
10		in excess of 10,000 people; and				
11	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council constitutes the CHR Program as a priority of				
12		the Papago Tribe for the following reasons:				
13	CHR's	- provide direct health care services;				
14		- follow up health services for discharged patients;				
15		- refer patients to health centers or clinics;				
16		<ul> <li>arrange transportation for patients to health clinics or centers;</li> </ul>				
17		<ul> <li>provide health education to patients at their homes and/or health workshops;</li> </ul>				
18		<ul> <li>are first responders to accident victims or to the seriously ill patients;</li> </ul>				
19		<ul> <li>make medical needs, dental, and eye appointments, as well as other specialty type clinic appointments;</li> </ul>				
20		<ul> <li>promote self care in health to people through home visits, at schools and at the Papago Children's Home;</li> </ul>				
21 22		<ul> <li>stage patients with upper respiratory infections, impetigo, and diarrhea issuing protocol, and issuing over the counter medications to those requiring it;</li> </ul>				
23		- read skin tests for cocci and tuberculosis and reporting				
24		the results to the Community Health Nursing Office for recording into the patient's medical record, and for				
25		treatment if needed;				
26		<ul> <li>take throat cultures on patients visited to screen for streptococcus infections;</li> </ul>				
27		<ul> <li>provide patient interpretation and for the physician if required, for better understanding between physician and patient;</li> </ul>				
28		- explain to patients any medical procedures, equipment
