

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Supporting CHR Program)

RES. NO. 08-82

1 WHEREAS, the National CHR Association has scheduled its annual conference
2 in Washington, D. C., for February 22-24, 1982, to address the
3 issues and the future of the CHR Programs nation-wide; and
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Nation is comprised of four (4) reservation bodies, all
5 of which are separate, Gila Bend - 10,400 acres; San Xavier -
6 71,095 acres; Florence - 20 acres; Sells (main reservation) -
7 2,744,894 acres; and
8 WHEREAS, the Papago CHR's have been and are a vital part of the health
9 delivery system on the Papago Reservations serving a population
10 in excess of 10,000 people; and
11 WHEREAS, the Papago Council constitutes the CHR Program as a priority of
12 the Papago Tribe for the following reasons:


- 13 CHR's - provide direct health care services;
14 - follow up health services for discharged patients;
15 - refer patients to health centers or clinics;
16 - arrange transportation for patients to health clinics
17 or centers;
18 - provide health education to patients at their homes
19 and/or health workshops;
20 - are first responders to accident victims or to the
21 seriously ill patients;
22 - make medical needs, dental, and eye appointments, as
23 well as other specialty type clinic appointments;
24 - promote self care in health to people through home
25 visits, at schools and at the Papago Children's Home;
26 - stage patients with upper respiratory infections, impetigo,
27 and diarrhea issuing protocol, and issuing over the
28 counter medications to those requiring it;
29 - read skin tests for cocci and tuberculosis and reporting
30 the results to the Community Health Nursing Office for
31 recording into the patient's medical record, and for
32 treatment if needed;
- take throat cultures on patients visited to screen for
streptococcus infections;
- provide patient interpretation and for the physician if
required, for better understanding between physician
and patient;
- explain to patients any medical procedures, equipment
to be used on them as ways of treatment, and what
surgery is about, etc.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
32 fully support the CHR Program and directs Papago attendees at


1 the conference to testify in favor of the CHR Program for all
2 of the foregoing reasons.

3 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 11th
4 day of January, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
5 of 1090. for; 0 against; 58. not voting; and 2 absent,
6 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (e)
7 and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
8 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
9 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
10 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
11 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
12 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
