

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Highway Maintenance Camp Lease/Pisinemo District

RES. NO. 101-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe entered into an Agreement with the Department of
2 Transportation Highway Division, State of Arizona, on July 1, 1950,
3 to lease the following described property, known as Tracy's
4 Highway Maintenance Camp, to-wit:


5 a 200' x 200' parcel of land lying 100' southerly of and
6 at right angles to the center lane of State Highway 86,
7 extending from Highway Engineer Station 1928 +00 to
8 Highway Engineer State 1930 +00; and

8 WHEREAS, on July 13, 1982, the Pisinemo District Council did meet with Mr.
9 Larry Issac and Mr. William Harrison on behalf of the Arizona
10 Department of Transportation Highway Division and did support
11 execution of a new lease of said property for a period of five
12 years starting July 1, 1982, at a rental of \$732.00 per year.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve
14 execution of a lease with the State Department of Transportation
15 of the property known as Tracy's Highway Maintenance Camp for a
16 period of five (5) years, commencing July 1, 1982, at an annual
17 rental of \$732.00 payable to the Papago Tribe and to be shared
18 equally between the Papago Tribe and the Pisinemo District.


19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
20 day of August, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
23 (c) and Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the
24 Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December
25 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
26 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
27 Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is
28 effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
