

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
RAINBOW VALLEY

RES. NO. 105-82

1 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Arizona did by Section 36-2802 of  
2 the Arizona Revised Statutes designate and direct the acquisition  
3 of lands in the Rainbow Valley as a hazardous waste disposal  
4 facility site for the State of Arizona; and


5 WHEREAS, such site is located entirely on Federal land and is contiguous to  
6 both the Bosque and Vekol Valley aquifers which adjoin and underly  
7 the Papago and Gila Bend Reservations; and

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council finds that the location and use of a hazardous  
9 waste disposal facility in the Rainbow Valley will constitute a  
10 threat to human health and to the environment, geology and hydrology  
11 of the Papago and Gila Bend Reservations and to the aquifers of the  
12 Bosque and Vekol Valleys.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does object to  
14 the location of a hazardous waste disposal facility within the  
15 Rainbow Valley and does hereby urgently request the Federal Govern-  
16 ment to refuse the transfer and use of federal lands within the  
17 Valley for such purpose.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th  
19 day of August, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
20 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,  
21 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (c)  
22 and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
