

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Approving Interim FY 1983 Tribal Budgets)

RES. NO. 118-82

1 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has made recommendations to  
2 the Papago Council concerning anticipated revenues and proposed  
3 expenditures of the Papago Tribe, including possible budget  
4 increases which would result from a suggested ten percent (10%)  
5 employee merit increase, for the 1983 fiscal year; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has determined that, because tribal revenues  
7 will not permit pay increases, the Papago Tribe will not allow  
8 merit pay increases for any tribal employees in fiscal year  
9 1983; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been advised that the Noranda Mining  
11 Company is suggesting a reduction in minimum royalty payments  
12 to the Tribe because of depressed market conditions, and the  
13 Council is consequently concerned about making extended budgetary  
14 commitments at this time; and

15 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendations of the Budget  
16 and Finance Committee and has approved the attached Papago Tribal  
17 Budget, without allowance for merit pay increases, as an interim  
18 budget of three (3) months, commencing October 1, 1982 and ending  
19 December 31, 1982.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
21 approve and adopt the attached FY 1983 Papago Tribal Budget as  
22 an interim budget for a period of three (3) months, commencing  
23 October 1, 1982 and ending December 31, 1982 and does hereby  
24 authorize the expenditures of tribal funds in accordance therewith.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon review of the budget within the foregoing  
26 three month period, the Papago Council will reconsider the  
27 possibility of including cost of living and merit pay increases  
28 for tribal employees in subsequent budgets.

29 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th  
30 day of September, 1982 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
31 of 957.0 for; 66.5 against; 124.5 not voting; and 4 absent,  
32 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of  
Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of


1 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of  
2 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is  
subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


