

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Request to Recontract P.L. 93-638 with Indian Health Service)
(for two Papago Tribal Health Programs for FY 1982 - 1983)

RES. NO. 121-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the following
2 programs under FY 1982 P.L. 93-638 service contracts with the
3 Public Health, Indian Health Service;

4 Papago Psychological Service
5 Papago Alcoholism and Prevention Program

6 WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
7 Papago Tribe and its people; and

8 WHEREAS, 25 CFR 371.20 of the Federal Regulations require that all proposals
9 to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tribal Council
10 for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract termination;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council does desire to recontract for provision
13 of these services during FY 1983.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does
15 authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service to
16 contract with the Papago Tribe under P.L. 93-638 regulations and
17 procedures for the provision of services titled:

18 249-79-0015 Papago Psychological Service
19 249-79-0010 Papago Alcoholism and Prevention Program

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall be from
21 October 01, 1982 through September 30, 1983, unless extended by
22 mutual agreement of both parties.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event that these contracts do not become
24 effective on October 01, 1982, continuation of these programs will
25 be based on an extension of the existing 1982 contracts until such
26 time that the 1983 contracts become effective.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate programs
28 for which contracts are requested herewith which have not been
29 negotiated and executed by the Indian Health Service prior to the
30 start of the funding year.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence,
32 Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman, or Ms. Rosita Ruiz,
33 Treasurer, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these
34 contracts and any amendments thereto for the duration of the
35 contracts.

36 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 13th
37 day of September, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
38 of 1121.0 for; 27.0 against; 0 not voting; and 4 absent,
39 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d)
40 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
41 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
42 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
43 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
44 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
45 by the Papago Council.


