

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Hickiwan District 1983 Revenue Sharing Budget


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has appropriated \$11,642.45 to the
2 Hickiwan District to be budgeted and spent in accordance with
3 General Revenue Sharing Rules and Regulations; and
4 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District offered testimony at the Revenue Sharing
5 Public Hearings regarding the need to replace a van used for
6 transporting students to Ajo High School; and
7 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council did meet on August 28, 1982, to
8 discuss the Revenue Sharing budget and reaffirmed the testimonies
9 presented at the public hearings; and
10 WHEREAS, the amount appropriated by the Papago Council is not enough to
11 pay for the total replacement cost of \$15,000.00 needed for the
12 van; and
13 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council has agreed and authorized the use
14 of District monies to cover the deficiency.
15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
16 approve and authorize the Hickiwan District to use the Revenue
17 Sharing appropriation of \$11,642.45 towards the cost of replacing
18 the van (\$15,000.00) used for transportation of students to Ajo
19 High School, and to supplement the deficiency from District funds.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th
21 day of October, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
22 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
24 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
enactment by the Papago Council.
