WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has developed and adopted an interim budget for FY 1982-83, designed to deliver services to its members; and

WHEREAS, the interim budget proposes expenditures for 3 months subject to amendments or modifications as may be necessary; and

WHEREAS, the General Council recognizes the importance of the Districts needs and the services designed to address them.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve and authorize expenditures by the San Lucy District Council in accordance with the interim budget proposed and any and all amendments, modifications or changes shall be subject to Council review and approval.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th day of October, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
