

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Gu Vo District 1983 Revenue Sharing Budget

RES. NO. 128-82

1 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Council did accept the Papago Council's revenue
2 sharing appropriation of \$11,642.45 to be budgeted and spent in
3 accordance with General Revenue Sharing Rules and Regulations; and
4 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District held a public hearing to identify and prioritize
5 its District needs; and
6 WHEREAS, the members of the Gu Vo District did prioritize Education as a
7 basic need for its people; and
8 WHEREAS, the District Council has developed an education program with goals
9 and objectives along with a budget; and
10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the proposed education program and
11 budget and supports the goals and objectives identified by the
12 Gu Vo District.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does approve
14 and authorize expenditures for the budget line items identified
15 in the budget adopted by the Gu Vo District Council to implement
16 its Education Program.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th
18 day of October, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
21 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
22 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
23 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
25 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
26 its enactment by the Papago Council.
