

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Authorizing Funds for Redirections -  
District Recruitment Program

RES. NO. 129-82

1 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Council has recognized that education is a  
2 menas by which to obtain and maintain self-sufficiency; and  
3 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District has developed a preliminary outline entitled  
4 Redirections which identifies educational objectives to be  
5 achieved; and  
6 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District realizes that sovereignty will be preserved  
7 and advanced by this education program; and  
8 WHEREAS, the General Council encourages and supports Gu Vo District in its  
9 education program; and  
10 WHEREAS, by Gu Vo District Council Resolution # 20-82, dated October 8,  
11 1982, the District Council did express its intent to designate  
12 all interest earned on its IIM Account to be reserved for the  
13 funding of the Redirections Program.  
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve  
15 and support the intent of the Gu Vo District to designate all  
16 interest monies earned on its IIM Account for the future funding  
17 of the Redirections Program and that funds will be expended  
18 pursuant to budgets prepared and administered by the District.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th  
20 day of October, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
21 of 932.0 for; 117.0 against; 99.0 not voting; and 1 absent,  
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of  
23 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
24 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of  
the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is  
subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
