

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Supporting the Guiding Star Lodge


1 WHEREAS, the Phoenix Service Unit Indian Health Advisory Board, Inc., is  
2 a Tribal Organization as described in P.L. 93-638; and  
3 WHEREAS, the Phoenix Service Unit Indian Health Advisory Board, Inc., has  
4 been providing Alcoholism Services to women and their children  
5 at the Guiding Star Lodge for four (4) years; and  
6 WHEREAS, the Guiding Star Lodge has been supported through a Block Grant  
7 from the Department of Health and Human Services, Alcohol, Drug  
8 Abuse and Mental Health Administration (ADMS); and  
9 WHEREAS, the Phoenix Service Unit Indian Health Advisory Board, Inc., is  
10 desirous of continuing services at the Guiding Star Lodge; and  
11 WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services has  
12 the authority to provide Block Grants to Tribal Organizations.  
13 NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Papago Council requests that  
14 the Secretary provide a Block Grant to the Phoenix Service Unit  
15 Indian Health Advisory Board, Inc., to support the Guiding Star  
16 Lodge for fiscal year 1983.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 19th  
18 day of October, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
19 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,  
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of  
21 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
22 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
23 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
24 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
25 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
26 its enactment by the Papago Council.
