

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Baboquivari Revenue Sharing)

RES. NO. 140-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 54-82 appropriate  
2 \$11,642.45 of Revenue Sharing money to each of the eleven  
3 (11) Districts; and

4 WHEREAS, on October 26, 1982, the Baboquivari District Council had its  
5 planning meeting to determine the distribution of their share  
6 of Revenue Sharing money; and

7 WHEREAS, the District Council has determined that each village is aware of  
8 the needs of their people, such as home repairs or any type of  
9 unforeseen emergencies; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is in agreement of same.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
12 approve of the Baboquivari District Council distributing  
13 \$1,940.40 to each of the six villages within the District for  
14 home repair or any emergency that may be caused by rain, fire,  
15 or any other unforeseen disasters.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th  
17 day of November, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
18 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,  
19 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f)  
20 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
21 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
22 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
23 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by  
24 the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment  
25 by the Papago Council.
