3	declared surplus to the needs of the Papago Agency to the Papago

6	that it would be in the best interest of the Papago Tribe and						
7	the Gu Achi District to receive such buildings and related						
8	personal property.

10	request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to transfer the following						
11	buildings to the Papago Tribe:						
12	1. Building No. 409, of cement block construction, located						
13	at Old Santa Rosa and consisting of approximately 2,798 sq. ft.						
14	 Building No. 58, of adobe construction, located in Sells and consisting of approximately 910 sq. ft. 						
15	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th						
16	day ofNovember, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote						
17	of <u>1121.0</u> for; <u>0</u> against; <u>27.0</u> not voting; and <u>1</u> absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 2 (b) of Anticle V of the Constitution and By lays of the Papage Tribe						
18	Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to						
19	Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the						
20	date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
