

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Appointing Directors of Management
Board of Papago Farming Authority

RES. NO. 151-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution 72-79, establish the Papago
2 Farming Authority and adopt a Plan of Operation granting management
3 power to a Management Board of eight persons, five of whom must be
4 members of the Papago Tribe and three of whom must be persons having
5 not less than ten years' experience in farming or business manage-
ment of substantial character; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on November 5, 1980, by Resolution No. 121-80
7 appoint eight persons to the Management Board upon alternating
terms; and

8 WHEREAS, the term of office of W. W. "Pat" Garrett has expired and it is
9 necessary to appoint or reappoint a person having not less than
10 ten years' experience in farming or business management of sub-
stantial character to such office; and

11 WHEREAS, the terms of office of Tony Felix and Archie Hendricks have also
12 expired and it is necessary to appoint or reappoint two members of
the Tribe to such offices.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, in accordance
14 with the provisions of Section 8 of the Plan of Operation of the
15 Papago Farming Authority, the following persons meeting the
16 required qualifications are hereby appointed as directors of the
17 Management Board for a term of three years and until their
successors have been appointed and qualified:



21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1st
22 day of December, 1982, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
23 of 1064.0 for; 0 against; 84.0 not voting; and 1 absent,
24 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
25 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
26 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
27 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
28 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
29 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
30 enactment by the Papago Council.
