

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Approving and Adopting FY 1983 Tribal Budget

RES. NO. 153-82

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on September 13, 1982, by Resolution No.
2 118-82, approve and adopt an interim FY 1983 Tribal Budget author-
3 izing the expenditure of \$539,740.00 of tribal funds for a period
4 of three (3) months commencing October 1, 1982 and ending December
5 31, 1982, pending resolution of a request by Noranda Lakeshore
6 Mines, Inc., ("Noranda") to reduce and/or defer certain royalty
7 payments to the Papago Tribe; and
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 144-82, approve the defer-
9 ment of \$60,000.00 in monthly payments of advance royalties by
10 Noranda, conditioned upon receipt by the Tribe of funds to be made
11 available to the Papago Council under the provisions of an approved
12 judgment fund distribution plan contained in Senate Bill 1986; and
13 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the recommendations of the Budget
14 and Finance Committee as reflected in the attached FY 1983 Papago
15 Tribal Budget, and approves of same, without allowance for merit
16 pay increases, and approves the expenditure of the sum of \$1,615,260.
17 of tribal funds for the remaining nine (9) months of the Tribe's
18 1983 fiscal year, commencing January 1, 1983 and ending September
19 30, 1983.
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
21 approve and adopt the attached FY 1983 Papago Tribal Budget, with-
22 out allowance for merit pay increases, for the remaining nine (9)
23 months of the Tribe's 1983 fiscal year, commencing January 1, 1983
24 and ending September 30, 1983, and does hereby authorize the
25 expenditure of tribal funds in accordance therewith.

26 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 1st
27 day of December, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
28 of 607.0 for; 492.0 against; 49.0 not voting; and 1 absent,
29 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and
30 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
31 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
32 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is
subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
